Alison and Lynne explained that with the change in CII focus from exams to Mixed Assessment, a new approach & skill set was required by CII candidates. Mixed Assessment required candidates to demonstrate their theoretical knowledge in the multiple-choice exam & their practical knowledge/experience in the coursework component. Their revision presentation highlighted a structured route to CII students studies including: • How to master the syllabus & focus on learning objectives; • How to prepare for the MCQ exam; • How to deconstruct coursework questions; • How to plan your written answers to maximise marks.
