Global trends in life insurance

In this IIL lecture Jules Constantinou discussed the potential for new technology and the changing demands of consumers to disrupt how life and health insurance is bought, sold, priced and underwritten.

The convergence of factors in the biological, physical and digital world will bring waves of disruption to life insurers across the globe. New non-traditional players are starting to encroach on life insurers' domain – some by invitation and in collaboration. The influence of this new technology will fundamentally alter the life and health insurance market. The rapid pace of change will see new providers adopting radically different ways of engagement and providing new services that put the customer at the centre. This will ultimately lead to greater use of data analytics and automation.
