In this IIL lecture Dr Maynard talked about research the Innovation Team had published over the previous year on a variety of risk topics and gave a heads up on what is to come in 2018.

Innovation can take many forms from the use of new technologies to streamline processes through to creatively exploiting a better understanding for risk. This lecture covered Lloyd's recent publications on Counterfactual risk analysis, Cloud Cyber attacks, Marine extreme risks modelling, Middle East Quake risk and Liability risk modelling. Some areas of focus for 2018 were also be highlighted including: Mining, Supply chain risks, Crop covers in India and the new Digital Economy.

- Various methodologies for assessing risks
