then refer suitable cases to Shelter to benefit from their in-depth housing advice in conjunction with our help.

This is just one way in which we are partnering with other charities to enable insurance people to access expert support and advice with a range of health and other life issues.

Case Study

Sophie and Greg have two Children, the younger of whom is blind and deaf and will be confined to a wheelchair for the rest of his life. Both have worked in insurance.

It was proving impossible for Sophie to get her child up the stairs to the couple's first floor flat. The only house they could afford needed a lot of work doing to it and the garden was in an awful state. Family and friends provided as much practical help as they could and we were asked if we could finance adaptations as the wait for local authority help was very long. We have been able to help the family transform their property to meet their needs as a family and we are now providing finance to make the garden a safe and happy place for the children and somewhere in





which Greg and Sophie can relax. The family has been overwhelmed by the support the insurance industry's charity has given to them and said "We are isolated as a family, due to our son's condition. Thank you doesn't seem enough. You have honestly changed our lives. You have made us feel incredibly lucky."



We had the pleasure of attending the Insurance Endurance event in June at the PFI karting racecourse in Grantham. Organised by Bankstone Insurance they generously chose us as their charity partners for the event. Teams raced for six hours to compete for top place and the mixed weather made it a challenging race for all.
