

Treasurer's Report for the year to 31 December 2017

Summary:

The Guernsey Insurance Institute has continued to apply its income in accordance with the aims of the Institute by organising a variety of regular and one-off events during the year, comprising a breakfast seminar with CII CEO Sian Fisher, revision courses aimed at students provided by Searchlight Solutions Limited, the 4th Annual "Development Day" and the regular monthly programme of "CPD" events on a variety of insurance related topics.

Charitable Funds raised in the year continue to reflect credit on the Insurance Sector for the generosity of its members.

The Annual Dinner was a success, acknowledged by members and guests. The exercise of strict control of costs and insistence on value for money resulted in a modest surplus.

Income & Expenditure:

"Educational" events have been been subsidised for the benefit of members and as far as possible "social" events have been run to break even. The GTA sponsorship provides our students with subsidised use of the GTA study facilities. The largest item of expenses continues to be the President's and Council's Expenses due to the unavailability of direct support from employers as previously reported. The activities of the Council continue to be controlled to ensure that your Council provide "value for money" in meeting the aims of the Institute and enhancing the awareness of the contribution the Institute make to the Guernsey Insurance Industry and beyond. The actual cost of the Annual Dinner and how it was funded is shown in a special note.

Balance Sheet:

The Accumulated Fund has reduced by £1,025. This is consistent with CII policy that Local Institutes should not hold excessive reserves.

Bursary Fund and Charitable Funds:

In line with the report for 2016, Charitable Funds were distributed to the Insurance Charities and the "Friends of Anthony Thomas". The funds raised in 2017 will be distributed in 2018 to the Insurance Charities and the President's chosen charity, Guernsey Mind.
