In this IIL property lecture James Spencer discussed the origins of terrorism, how it has changed over time, and the direction in which it seems to be moving.

Terrorism has been around for far longer than many people imagine. It has changed – and broadened – over the years in both its target set and its capability. Terrorists have changed their organisational habits, and are also changing their strategic intention to match both that and the change in the business and political environment. While the security services and agencies have done an impressive job of preventing much terrorism, they will not be lucky every time, and companies must prepare to mitigate against an attack.
