In this IIL aviation lecture Jane Middleton outlined the importance of aviation to the UK, not just in terms of the volume of passengers and cargo but also people employed, investment and contribution to the GDP. Jane's presentation covered three main areas, namely Aviation 2050, UK Aviation post Brexit and the Independent Airline Insolvency Review. Jane also explained how Airlines UK work with governments, regulators and legislators to promote the interests of UK airlines, and with organisations across the sector to encourage long-term and sustainable growth in aviation. In addition to looking at the risks arising from Brexit, Jane also briefly looked at other risks the UK airlines face.
