These insights have been gained primarily from her experiences as a CII Senior Examiner & Marker. Alison explained that with the change in CII focus from exams to Mixed Assessment, a new approach & skill set was required by CII candidates. Mixed Assessment required candidates to demonstrate their theoretical knowledge in the multiple-choice exam & their practical knowledge/experience in the coursework component. Her revision presentation highlighted a structured route to CII students studies.
