Data protection in the insurance industry, one year on

Anthony Woolich and Felicity Burling recapped the position for organisations in the insurance industry under the relevant General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) legislation and the Data Protection Act 2018, and flagged data protection issues particularly relevant to the insurance industry nearly one year after implementation.

- What you can do to ensure that your organisation remains compliant.
