

Charity Visitor Report

During the last year I did make 11 visits to families in sufficient distress that they needed to contact the Charities with a cry for help. 4 of the families we have worked with during the previous year however 7 of the families were new to us.

As you can imagine each family was facing hardship in one way or another, some circumstances were quite distressing. I am delighted to report that the Charities have been able to provide assistance to each of the families in a way to suit each of their individual needs.

How much help have the Charities given to families in our catchment area ?

We currently have 24 active Beneficiaries in our area,

During 2019 the Charities made awards of £99,073.50 - predominately for day to day hardship,

they gave out 1 summer Hamper and

gave out 18 Christmas Hampers

This spotlights what the Charities have done to help families in our area and may I ask that we continue to support the Charities by giving generously during the Awareness Week in order that they are able to continue with their work - Thank you.
