Timing - consider how slowly to speak

Confidence level - how comfortable you are in this situation

Preparations needed - what you need to have to hand and do beforehand

Rapport - consider whether you have or could build a rapport with the audience

- 2. Breathe in and out deeply five times
- 3. 'M' sound keep sound at the front of your mouth

 - 2. He Has Huge Hair
- 6. Scale la la la la la la la la la la
- 7. 'M' words say twice, breathe out on last syllable -
