

Sandy Park Code of Conduct

The following Code of Conduct has been developed to ensure a safe and secure environment for all those attending Sandy Park.

BOOKING

- 1. All bookings must provide a lead contact in order to assist with NHS track and trace requirements.**
- 2. Lifts are reserved for those with accessibility needs.**

ON-SITE FACILITIES

- 1. Please use the hand sanitiser stations regularly.**
- 2. Toilet facilities will be available in each designated area and kept to a very high standard of cleanliness.**

WELL-BEING

- 1. You must not attend if you are suffering from any COVID-19 symptoms and/or required to self-isolate.**
- 2. You should assess the risk associated with attending, both at the point of purchase and on the day, and in relation to your own personal circumstances, age, group size and make-up, health status and susceptibility to infection.**
- 3. We encourage attendees to carry out a Lateral Flow Test before attending an event**
- 4. Face Coverings are encouraged to be worn in public areas of the building and all our staff will be wearing masks to ensure safety of our guests.**
