- Professional Standards: Melissa to give updates over the next 12 months
 - Looking for direction as to how local institutes can help promote professional standards
 Potentially a theme each month
 - Working parties all members of both groups can expect comms soon
 - David Ross will lead Communications
 - Ian Callaghan will lead Funding

• Grants for 2022

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- o All funding comms sent just before Christmas
- Trade press picked up on this and got positive publicity
 - Past 12 months not necessarily reflective of upcoming operating costs
 - David Ross to discuss with the board
 - Special grant process to remain as per 2021 highlighted in comms so far)

Insurance Museum

- Established as a charity in 2020
- Virtual gallery & website to be launched in early 2022
- o Will begin with a focus on property, other LOBs to be added over time
- Ultimately a physical centre in EC3
- o David Irvine will raise the question of how local institutes can contribute and let us know
- Finances
 - o Need formalised feedback and reporting from the Board
 - From 2016 to cover the manifesto and the financial impact of this
 - o Board meeting end of March, to be discussed at the next LINF meeting after this
