COUNTDOWN TO THE CONFERENCE!




Only 11 days now before our first all-day Conference with North Downs Institute finally happens. A few places are still available - first come, first served - just visit our website for details.

The aftermath of a fire, especially witness evidence and debris, gives so many clues to a trained expert, and Luke will bring the investigative thought processes to life, illustrated by photos from real cases.
