About The Future Leader's Programme

The Future Leaders Programme is an exciting new initiative from The Insurance Institute of Cardiff, designed to support the development of emerging talent within our local insurance and financial services community.

This programme is built to support, coach, teach, and nurture individuals who demonstrate leadership potential and a commitment to personal and professional growth. Through a structured series of workshops, mentoring, and leadership experiences, delegates will gain the skills and confidence to take the next step in their careers and/or compliment their current roles.

By the end of the programme, successful participants will achieve a **Level 3 Certificate in Leadership and Management**, awarded by the **Institute of Leadership & Management (ILM)** – a nationally recognised qualification.

Key Information

- Limited to **12 places** for the 2025 cohort
- Cost: **£350 per delegate**; a small contribution towards the overall cost of the programme.
- **One delegate** per organisation due to limited capacity
- If multiple applications are received from the same organisation, we will liaise with the application sponsors to agree on the delegate selected for this year's cohort

Eligibility Criteria

To apply, candidates must:

- Live or work in Cardiff Capital Region (to meet qualification criteria)
- Be a current member of the **Cardiff Insurance Institute**

Commitment

By applying for the programme, you must have a sponsor. This can be the head of your organisation, head of department, your direct line manager or even your mentor.

Both candidate and mentor must commit to the programme. All face-to-face workshops must be attended by the delegate and must complete any assignments and coursework required by the programme to achieve completion of the programme and ILM Certification. Webinars are highly recommended as part of the programme.
