## **Aviation Cyber**

In this IIL lecture James reviewed the cyber security risk within the aviation sector, its likely evolution and the implications for cyber insurance.

James explained that the aviation industry was subject to challenging profit margins and high safety requirements, and its participants were dependent on heavily interconnected systems to ensure they continue to operate efficiently. These factors meant that the sector was vulnerable to the continuing escalation and evolution of cyber attacks – particularly if it came to be targeted more directly. As insurance was increasingly seen as an important element in organisation's cyber risk management strategy, it was important to understand how these risks were likely to play out in practice.

- How these risks are likely to evolve in the coming years
- Implications for the use of insurance for cyber risk management
