Sporting liabilities - key legal principles and long term liabilities

In this IIL lecture Jonathan Bellamy discussed the central legal and insurance issues relevant to sports injury claims in professional and amateur sport and the difficult questions arising for practitioners in long term liability claims – including CTE and cancer.

This lecture covered the applicable legal standard of care, recurrent issues in legal sports claims, typical insurance issues, analysis of potential long term liabilities and how they affect the insurance market and the place of arbitration in sports injury claims.

- nature of recurring insurance issues in this sector
- potential for long term liabilities for sports injuries and challenging insurance issues arising.
