Global Collaboration, Frontline Results: safety in offshore helicopter operations

In this IIL lecture Gretchen Haskins spoke about the safety collaboration set up amongst competing companies in the offshore helicopter industry. Her presentation included a description of the proactive and strategic approach to delivering those actions that make the greatest difference to frontline safety worldwide. In her lecture, Gretchen considered how to use the intellect and resources of multiple organisations to drive improvement that would not be possible by individual companies. It looked at an alliance of all key stakeholders to drive breakthroughs in performance. Her presentation also considered safety as a performance improvement activity, rather than a risk management one.

- The potential of collaboration to achieve breakthroughs in safety performance
- Use of proactive, performance based methods to improve safety
