They looked at the parties involved in a construction contract: JCT contract conditions; CCIP and OCIP; cover provided under existing property insurances; project specific contract works insurance; advanced loss of profit; existing structures; JCT 6.5.1; public liability; Joint Code of Practice and water damage on constructions sites.

- The contract works cover provided under a typical Property Owners wording
- The implications for Property cover on existing buildings incl. where the Employer is not the landlord or freeholder
- Contract works insurance and what are the benefits of an Owner Controlled Programme (OCIP)
- The main types of cover available under an OCIP e.g. loss of income/delayed start up (DSU), JCT clause 6.5.1 perils and PL
- Risk management on construction sites Joint Code of Practice
