## A perspective from Europe on Brexit

In this IIL lecture, Dr Michael Menhart talked about the Brexit process from a European perspective. In his presentation, Michael outlined the internal and external political challenges, economic impact, key issues, the potential outcomes and their implications for UK and the EU.

Michael indicated that the long-term economic consequences of the Brexit decision is likely to depend on the future trade agreement between UK and the EU. He foresaw a period of political uncertainty for both parties – and for the entire financial services industry as the EU entered Brexit negotiations in a time of increasing internal and external political pressure. Michael concluded that it would be beneficial for all sides to keep close ties, but felt that economic rationale may not be the decisive element in the negotiations.
