Obtaining a Licence

- Must be 16 years of age older
- Attend an NQE (National Qualified Entity), there are 33 in the UK
- 1-3 days of classroom lessons and exercises
- A written theory test
- A flight assessment
- Prepare an Operations Manual
- Evidence of Insurance







Commercial Use Commercial defined as: The use of the UAS for the benefit of third parties, in exchange for remuneration.

Insurance Coverage for Drones

- Hull
- Hull War

- Spares & Detachable Payloads
- Invasion of Privacy
- Noise Liability
- Cyber



Insurance Coverage for Drones

- Agreed Values up to £100,000 (100% markets)
- Third Party Liability up to £50,000,000
- Deductible 10%
- (can be increased to reduce the premium)
- No cover for home built equipment



Insurance Coverage for Drones

Spares & Detachable Payloads

- Includes Ground equipment,
- Launch systems



- Spare batteries
- Drone spare parts.



Legislation and Insurance

There are Civil Aviation Authority rules regarding:

- maximum heights,
- minimum distance from people and property
- flights to be within line of sight, and
- well away from aircraft and airfields.
- Legal liability of operators.
