Tom's lecture reviewed how far the early days of the Republican-controlled Federal Government suggestion that by November 2017 we will have seen major change with respect to the Federal Government's a) oversight of the nation's insurance markets and our largest insurers, b) management of the Federal flood insurance program, c) negotiation of insurance trade deals (i.e. covered agreements) and d) relationship with state insurance regulators have materialised.
